



HILLCREST UNIFORM POLICY

All K-12 students are required to be in uniform whenever they are participating in campus life. All pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, sweaters, blouses, and neckwear must be purchased through Corporate Images.

Undershirts must be solid white with no lettering or pictures. Long undershirts must not be worn with short sleeve oxfords or polos.

As published in previous handbooks, all outerwear without school logo must be solid navy. However, seniors may wear sweatshirts with college logos daily, and freshmen, sophomores, and juniors may wear sweatshirts with college logos on Fridays.

Only solid dark/medium blue, black, grey, or white socks or tights may be worn with the uniform. Sheer knee-high stockings are not permitted. Colors should coordinate with the uniform worn.

Basic shoe color is limited to dark/medium shades of blue (no turquoise), brown, grey, black or white in color. An additional hint of color trim is acceptable. Shoes must have a closed toe and heel with rubber soles, and they should have a heel no higher than two inches. This is requested to ensure the safety of all students. Elementary students should only wear laced/Velcro athletic type shoes as they must participate in P.E. every day. All footwear should be in good repair. Shoes should not have characters on them. High-topped boots and western boots are not appropriate for school. During the months of November through March only, high school girls may wear Ugg-type boots in the same permitted shoe colors.

All students are required to wear the designated chapel attire to chapel. Chapel wear may be worn on other days, if so desired.

Elementary girls must wear shorts under their skirts to ensure modesty when participating in P.E. or when playing on the playground equipment. Secondary girls must wear shorts or “boy shorts” under their skirts to ensure modesty.

All skirt lengths may be no shorter than 3” above the knee, both front and back. Please allow for student growth when hemming skirts. Wearing leggings under the skirt does not change the length requirement.

Students may wear HCS logo clothing from previous years. Any HCS logo shirt, letterman jacket, sweater, and sweatshirt is acceptable, so long as it meets the minimum standards for good repair.

Field Trip Uniform

Depending upon the nature of the field trip, students will be directed to wear one of three field trip uniforms.

Chapel attire: School polo shirts with appropriate uniform pants, skirts, skorts, or shorts.

Designated attire approved by the administrator depending upon the nature of the field trip

Chapel Attire

Every grade has a designated set of clothing that must be worn to chapel. All shirts must be worn tucked in to chapel. Parents, please read entire section.

K-3rd Girls: Plaid jumper, peter pan blouse, or sailor blouse with tie

4th–6th Girls: Plaid skirt with white oxford shirt and uniform tie

K-6th Boys: Navy twill pants or shorts, white oxford shirt, and uniform tie

(No corduroy bottoms on chapel dress days) Elementary boys may remove their ties after chapel.

7th–8th Girls: Uniform skirt, white oxford shirt, and uniform tie

7th–8th Boys: Uniform pants, white oxford shirt, belt, and uniform tie

9th–12th Girls: Uniform skirt, white oxford shirt, and uniform tie to coordinate with skirt

9th–12th Boys: Uniform pants, white oxford shirt, belt, and uniform tie

Secondary students may only wear the navy uniform v-necked sweater or vest to chapel. Hooded sweatshirts must be removed for chapel, but may be worn for the remainder of the day. Shirts must be tucked in except during lunch time.

Consequences for Uniform Violation

Elementary students out of uniform may be suspended from class until the situation is corrected. Upper elementary students will receive a detention after three violations. Secondary students may be issued a detention and/or given a “special substitute” uniform. A parent or guardian will be notified if a student is suspended from class and will be asked to bring appropriate attire.
